Senior outfielder Aalia Bivens earned the team's first OVC Player of the Week honor since 2017 after a strong week of performances at home.

Bivens helped the Skyhawks go 5-1 last week while boasting a a .412 batting average with seven hits, three runs scored, one double, two home runs and 10 RBIs. She also posted a .412 on-base percentage while recording a slugging percentage of .824.

The Skyhawks (9-7) enter the field coming off of a near upset of No. 20 ranked Tennessee on Tuesday evening. UT Martin took an early lead in the contest before ultimately suffering a walk-off defeat to Tennessee by a final score of 3-2.

UT Martin boasts four players hitting well above .300 on the season. Sophomore Chelsey Gore leads the Skyhawks with a .449 batting average while tallying two doubles, two triples and four RBIs. Fellow sophomores Kaitlyn Kelley (.350, 5 doubles, two home runs and six RBIs) and Shyanne Sheffield (.341, one home run, nine RBIs) hit in the middle of the order while All-OVC honoree Paige Clark has notched a .327 batting average with three doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and eight steals on the season.

The Skyhawk pitching staff is led by its two starters in Erin Gallagher (5-3, 2.66 ERA) and Hannah Ridolfi (3-1, 2.14 ERA) who have combined for four complete games in 86.2 innings of work. Junior Seeley Layne (1-3, 2.10 ERA) has tossed 23.1 innings of relief.

UT Martin is 5-6 all-time against the tournament field. The Skyhawks boast a 4-1 record against Alcorn State while winning their lone matchup against UAB. Meanwhile, the Skyhawks are looking for their first win against Mississippi State after going 0-5 against the Bulldogs previously.



Brian Dunn enters his first season at the helm of the University of Tennessee at Martin softball history after being named the fourth head coach in program history on June 11, 2019.

Dunn brings over 26 years of championship experience at both the high school and collegiate level including two state championships and four national titles. He replaces long-time head coach Donley Canary, who retired after the 2019 season as the program's all-time winningest coach.

Heralded as the winningest softball coach in West Tennessee history, Dunn comes to UT Martin with a compiled record of 1,143 wins and 303 losses in 34 varsity seasons at the high school and college level. He has posted 857 career victories in 26 seasons as a head softball coach while also adding 286 wins as a volleyball coach at both Union University and the University School of Jackson. As a whole, he has overseen 63 team championships.

Dunn's most recent coaching stop has seen him turn USJ into a perennial state tournament threat since 2005 by accumulating a 344-102 record. During his tenure with the Bruins, the program won TSSAA state titles in 2010 and 2012, finished runner-up twice and claimed numerous district and region titles. His path to success was quick as he led the program to its first district championship in his fourth year before a state championship in his fifth season at the helm.

Prior to Dunn's illustrious career at USJ, he transformed Union University's softball program into a legitimate national title contender. He led the Lady Bulldogs softball program to a 449-108 record (.803 winning percentage) over a nine-year period. During his tenure, Union posted seven straight top-10 national rankings while earning six TranSouth Conference championships, four conference tournament championships and four NAIA Region XI championships. The Lady Bulldogs reached the pinnacle with three NCCAA National Championships and six NAIA World Series appearances, including a third-place finish in 2001 with a school record 63 wins.

In addition to coaching a top-ranked softball program, Dunn guided the Union volleyball program to a 243-62 record over its first seven seasons, including the inaugural season in 1998. Dunn led Union to three TranSouth regular season championships, two conference tournament championships and six straight NCCAA MidEast Region Titles while capturing the 2003 NCCAA National Volleyball Championship and finishing runner-up in 2001. In his final season, he led the team to the NAIA National Tournament with a top-10 NAIA finish.

During Dunn's eight-year tenure as a coach at Union, he coached 73 all-conference, 49 all-region, 28 All-American and 35 scholar-athlete award winners. Included in that list are 14 conference Players of the Year, nine region Players of the Year and two national Players of the Year. Individually, he claimed five NCCAA National Coach of the Year honors.

Dunn began his coaching career at Riverside High School where he led the Lady Panther softball team to their first-ever appearance in the TSSAA AA state tournament and a 64-25 record in three seasons.

Along with his numerous coaching achievements, Dunn has garnered 32 various Coach of the Year honors while being inducted into the Tennessee Softball Coaches Association Hall of Fame (2014), USJ Softball Hall of Fame (2016), Jackson Madison Country Sports Hall of Fame (2018) and Union University Sports Hall of Fame (2018).

Dunn is a 1989 graduate of San Diego State University, where he helped lead the baseball team to a Western Athletic Conference Championship and a top-25 national ranking. He graduated with a bachelor's degree in history before completing his master's in education in 1998 from Union.

Dunn is married to the former Emily Garrett, as the couple resides in Jackson. They have two daughters, Addison and Ashlee.

### QUICK HITS



#### BIVENS NAMD OVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior outfielder Aalia Bivens helped the Skyhawks post a 5-1 record at home while winning the Huddle House Classic to earn OVC Player of the Week honors on Feb. 24. The honor marked the first OVC Player of the Week accolade for the Skyhawks since the 2017 season.

For the week, Bivens posted a .412 batting average with seven hits, three runs scored, one double, two home runs and 10 RBIs. She also posted a .412 on-base percentage while recording a slugging percentage of .824.

Bivens tallied a three-run home run against Green Bay on Thursday afternoon before returning in the second half of the doubleheader and launching a grand slam to serve as the eventual game-winner. Then in the Huddle House Classic she went 5-for-10 while tallying three RBIs on the weekend.

#### SKYHAWKS WIN HUDDLE HOUSE CLASSIC

The Skyhawks won its Huddle House Classic by going 3-1 in a field which included Wright State and Purdue Fort Wayne. UT Martin scored 21 runs in the four games while posting a .299 batting average and converting 7-of-7 stolen base attempts.



#### PITCHING LEADS THE WAY

UT Martin's pitching staff has been strong so far this season, posting a team ERA of 2.35 through the first 16 games of the season. Seeley Layne (2.10 ERA) paces the team while Hannah Ridolfi (2.14) and Erin Gallagher (2.74) both boast sub-three ERAs.



#### CLARK CLIMBS PROGRAM LEADERBOARD

Junior Paige Clark continues to climb up the program's career leaderboard for stolen bases. After entering the season ranked tied for eighth all-time, Clark has taken sole possession of the spot with 54 career steals - including going 8-of-8 this season.

#### NEW YEAR, NEW FACES

The 2020 season is a year of transition for the Skyhawks as the program welcome's first-year head coach Brian Dunn to the helm after becoming the fourth head coach in UT Martin history back in June. Joining Dunn and staff will be a mixture of eight newcomers.

#### CLARK LEADS THE WAY

Junior Paige Clark garnered NFCA All-Region an All-OVC honors last season after a strong campaign. Clark posted a .383 batting average while tallying nine extra base hits, driving in 24 RBIs and swiping 34 stolen bases. Last season she strung together a streak of 29 games in which she reached base which ranked as the second longest in program history. Additionally, the righty posted a .494 batting average when leading off an inning.

#### UT MARTIN PICKED TO FINISH

In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, UT Martin has been tabbed to finish ninth in the quest for an Ohio Valley Conference championship. The Skyhawks claimed 92 total points.

#### SKYHAWKS ON THE MOVE

UT Martin proven to be a handful for opponents all last season when the Skyhawks placed runners on the basepaths. For the fourth year in a row, UT Martin eclipsed the 100-steal plateau. The Skyhawks tallied 130 stolen bases which ranked first in the OVC and sixth nationally. Five different players have eclipsed double figures in their steal total with Paige Clark leading the way with 34 while Madelyn Dycus (14), Gabbi Campbell (13) and Kenna Garst (11) also eclipsed double-figures.

So far this season, the Skyhawks have tallied 19 stolen bases while being caught just once.

#### SKYHAWKS NAMED EASTON/NFCA ALL-AMERICA SCHOLAR-ATHLETES

UT Martin softball team continued its tradition of strong academic success once again after being recognized by the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) as eight players were named 2018-19 Easton/NFCA Division I All-America Scholar-Athletes. To be eligible, honorees must have maintained a 3.5 GPA or higher.

#### ELEVEN SKYHAWKS NAMED TO OVC COMMISSIONER'S HONOR ROLL

UT Martin saw 128 student-athletes achieve at least a 3.25 Grade Point Average during the 2018-19 academic year, earning a spot on the OVC Commissioner's Honor Roll. Overall, 2,008 student-athletes were named to the OVC Commissioner's Honor Roll, setting a new record for the ninth straight year. The returning group of Aalia Bivens, Paige Clark, Madelyn Dycus, Erin Gallagher, Kenna Garst and Kallie Pickens were six of the 11 Skyhawks to be named to the honor roll.
