## **PLAYER TO WATCH**

Junior outfielder Kaci Fuller has been a big contributor for the Skyhawks all season while winning the OVC's batting crown with a .413 batting average.

Fuller is one of just three players in the league to post a batting average over .400 on the season while ranking as the program's all-time leader with a .383 career batting mark.

Fuller finished the season with a 1.123 OPS while adding nine doubles, three triples, seven home runs and 29 RBIs.

- The University of Tennessee at Martin softball team heads south to the Ohio Valley Conference Softball Championship to be contested at Choccolocco Park in Oxford, Ala. this week beginning on Wednesday, May 10 through Saturday, May 13. Every game will be broadcast on ESPN+.
- UT Martin will open the tournament with a first-round bye and await the winner between #5 seed SIUE and #8 seed Morehead State. The two programs will square off on Wednesday, May 10 with first pitch tentatively slated for 5:30 p.m.
- The Skyhawks (21-22) earned the fourth seed in the OVC Softball Championship
  after posting a 13-10 record in league play. UT Martin finished the regular season
  by winning four of its last six league series including sweeps of Lindenwood,
  SIUE and Tennessee Tech while leading the OVC in home runs (51), slugging
  percentage (.458) and fielding percentage (97.8 percent).
- Junior outfielder Kaci Fuller finished the regular season as the OVC's batting champion after pacing the league with a .413 batting average while ranking third overall with a 1.123 OPS (on-base + slugging). Also ranking amongst team leaders are sluggers Katie Dreiling and Kaitlyn Kelley who have excelled against OVC opponents. Dreiling has boasted a .355 batting average and 1.201 OPS in OVC action while tallying 10 home runs and 21 RBIs overall. Meanwhile, Kelley has done most of her damage in OVC play where she posted a .347 batting average while bashing five of her eight home runs on the year.
- The pitching staff has leaned heavily on the right arms of juniors Brooklynn Linneman (6-6, 2.86 ERA) and Dreiling (12-7, 2.90 ERA). Linneman leads the team with 20 starts and three shutouts on the year while posting a WHIP of 1.24 in 95.1 innings. Along with swinging a strong bat, Dreiling has been impressive in the circle where she posted nine of the team's 13 conference wins while leading the team with 96.2 innings pitched.
- This marks UT Martin's 23rd appearance in the event since the OVC Softball Championship's conception in 1994. The Skyhawks have posted a 34-41 all-time mark in the tournament while winning league crowns in 2009 and 2012.

# BRIAN DUNN HEAD COACH • 4TH YEAR

Brian Dunn enters his fourth season at the helm of the University of Tennessee at Martin softball history after being named the fourth head coach in program history on June 11, 2019.

Dunn brings over 29 years of championship experience at both the high school and collegiate level including two state championships and four national titles. For his career, he has posted a 522-156 record in his collegiate career - including a 73-48 record at UT Martin.

During his tenure at UT Martin, the Skyhawks have had eight all-conference performers including three first team selections and five second team honorees including Paige Clark, Kaci Fuller, Alexis Groet, Kaitlyn Kelley, Kallie Pickens and Shyanne Sheffield. The Skyhawks have also had five players named to the OVC All-Newcomer squad with Avry Blume, Fuller, Groet, Kelley and Sheffield earning those honors. Additionally, both Fuller and Groet have also earned NFCA All-Region honors.

The 2022 season marked the best season for the Skyhawks during the Dunn Era as the program posted a 34-19 record while going 17-8 in conference play. The team's 17 wins marked the most win against conference foes since the 2012 campaign while the squad posted 5.79 runs per game, 8.28 hits per game and had 278 RBIs which each ranked second in program single-season history. The Skyhawks also led the OVC in batting average (.305), runs (307), hits (439), RBIs (278) and fielding percentage (.970).

In his second season overall and first full campaign in 2021, Dunn led the team to a 27-19 mark while going 16-15 for the program's first winning record in Ohio Valley Conference action since 2017. The Skyhawks posted several statistical highlights including a school record 8.65 hits per game while ranking in the top-five in single-season history in six other categories of slugging percentage (.462, second), batting average (.309, third), runs per game (5.13, third), team hits (398, fifth) and fielding percentage (.965, fifth).

Under his direction, the tandem of Groet and Fuller each earned NFCA All-Region honors while a total of five individuals garnered postseason OVC accolades. The Skyhawks had a pair of All-OVC first team selections in Groet and Kelley while Fuller and Clark earned a spot on the All-OVC second team. Four players were recognized on the OVC All-Newcomer squad as Fuller, Groet and Kelley were joined on the list by Sheffield.

His debut season at UT Martin proved to be far from normal as the team played just 22 games before seeing the season come to an abrupt halt due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Despite the shortened season, the Skyhawks posted a 12-10 record prior to the cancelation.

Heralded as the winningest softball coach in west Tennessee history, Dunn has compiled record of 1,155 wins and 313 losses in 34 varsity seasons at the high school and college level. He has posted 869 career victories in 26 seasons as a head softball coach while also adding 286 wins as a volleyball coach at both Union University and the University School of Jackson. As a whole, he has overseen 63 team championships.

Dunn's most recent coaching stop has seen him turn USJ into a perennial state tournament threat since 2005 by accumulating a 344-102 record. During his tenure with the Bruins, the program won TSSAA state titles in 2010 and 2012, finished runner-up twice and claimed numerous district and region titles. His path to success was quick as he led the program to its first district championship in his fourth year before a state championship in his fifth season at the helm.

Prior to Dunn's illustrious career at USJ, he transformed Union University's softball program into a legitimate national title contender. He led the Lady Bulldogs softball program to a 449-108 record (.803 winning percentage) over a nine-year period. During his tenure, Union posted seven straight top-10 national rankings while earning six TranSouth Conference championships, four conference tournament championships and four NAIA Region XI championships. The Lady Bulldogs reached the pinnacle with three NCCAA National Championships and six NAIA World Series appearances, including a third-place finish in 2001 with a school record 63 wins.

In addition to coaching a top-ranked softball program, Dunn guided the Union volleyball program to a 243-62 record over its first seven seasons, including the inaugural season in 1998. Dunn led Union to three TranSouth regular season championships, two conference tournament championships and six straight NCCAA MidEast Region Titles while capturing the 2003 NCCAA National Volleyball Championship and finishing runner-up in 2001. In his final season, he led the team to the NAIA National Tournament with a top-10 NAIA finish.

During Dunn's eight-year tenure as a coach at Union, he coached 73 all-conference, 49 all-region, 28 All-American and 35 scholar-athlete award winners. Included in that list are 14 conference Players of the Year, nine region Players of the Year and two national Players of the Year. Individually, he claimed five NCCAA National Coach of the Year honors.

Dunn began his coaching career at Riverside High School where he led the Lady Panther softball team to their first-ever appearance in the TSSAA AA state tournament and a 64-25 record in three seasons.

Along with his numerous coaching achievements, Dunn has garnered 32 various Coach of the Year honors while being inducted into the Tennessee Softball Coaches Association Hall of Fame (2014), USJ Softball Hall of Fame (2016), Jackson Madison Country Sports Hall of Fame (2018) and Union University Sports Hall of Fame (2018)

Dunn is a 1989 graduate of San Diego State University, where he helped lead the baseball team to a Western Athletic Conference Championship and a top-25 national ranking. He graduated with a bachelor's degree in history before completing his master's in education in 1998 from Union.

Dunn is married to the former Emily Garrett, as the couple resides in Jackson. They have two daughters, Addison and Ashlee.



# **POSTSEASON ALL-OVC**







**OXFORD, Ala. –** On the eve of the 2023 Ohio Valley Conference Softball Championship, the league announced its postseason honorees as six University of Tennessee at Martin honorees were recognized with awards.

The league's head coaches and sports information directors voted Kaci Fuller as an All-OVC first team selection. Meanwhile, the trio of Kaitlyn Kelley, Avry Blume and Katie Dreiling were tabbed to the All-OVC second team. Rounding out the list were a pair of All-Newcomer selections by Brooklynn Linneman and Kiersten Nixon.

Hailing from Huntingdon, Tenn., Fuller won the league's overall batting title after pacing the OVC and ranking amongst national leaders with a .413 batting average. Along with her potent batting average, she tallied 23 runs scored, 57 hits, nine doubles, three triples, seven home runs and 29 RBIs. She boasted a .449 on-base percentage and .674 slugging percentage to post an impressive 1.123 OPS which ranked third in the league. Along with earning a pair of OVC Player of the Week honors, the junior outfielder opened the season with a 16-game hitting streak while tallying 17 multi-hit outings, including a season-best performance against Valparaiso when she notched four hits and five RBIs. This marks the third All-OVC selection for the program's all-time leader in batting average (.383).

Kelley, a Lexington, Tenn. native, has played and started in all 43 games for the Skyhawks this season at second base. Kelley turned it up in OVC play where she boasted a .347 batting average while hitting .283 overall with nine doubles, eight home runs and 21 RBIs. Along with ranking as the program's all-time leader in slugging percentage (.582) while sitting second in UT Martin history with 34 home runs, she is a two-time All-OVC selection after also earning first team honors in 2021. The slugger has tallied eight multi-hit performances while notching multi-RBIs in four games.

A 2022 OVC All-Newcomer selection, Blume elevated her game in her second season in a Skyhawk uniform. The Belvidere, Ill. native posted a .284 batting average with 21 runs scored, six doubles, four home runs and 19 RBIs on the season. Her season included a seven-game hitting streak while adding nine multi-hit performances. She played in 35 games in centerfield while adding a .986 fielding percentage with 70 putouts and two outfield assists.

Hailing from Jonesboro, Ark., Dreiling has been a valuable contributor for the Skyhawks on both sides of the ball. In the batter's box she posted a .321 batting average with 15 runs scored, three doubles, 10 home runs and 21 RBIs. She's notched a .420 on-base percentage to go with a .616 slugging percentage for an OPS of 1.045 on the year. The dual-threat posted nine multi-hit efforts while driving in a career-high five runs and hitting three home runs in a series against Lindenwood. Meanwhile in the pitcher's circle, she notched a 12-7 record with a 2.90 ERA in 96.2 innings of work. She was especially impressive against OVC foes where she won nine of the team's 13 league victories and posted a 1.67 ERA in 16 appearances. She was rewarded for her play during the regular season by being named both OVC Player and Pitcher of the Week on separate occasions.

Linneman, a Cleves, Ohio native, was a consistent performer for the Skyhawks in the pitching circle where she appeared in 25 games and led the team with 20 starts and three shutouts in her debut season. She posted a 6-6 record with a 2.86 ERA in 95.1 innings of work while striking out 79 batters and issuing just 33 walks. She limited opponents to a .235 batting average while posting shutouts against Valparaiso, Christian Brothers and Southern Indiana while adding a combined shutout against Morehead State.

A native of O'Fallon, Mo., Nixon was a two-way player for the Skyhawks in her debut season on the way to All-Newcomer honors. She posted a .284 batting average while adding 13 runs scored, six doubles, six home runs and 17 RBIs at the plate. She also made 15 appearances in the circle where she tossed 56.0 innings and picked up one victory. Her best game came against Memphis when she tied a school single-game record with three home runs in the neutral site matchup.
