Sophomore Chelsey Perry enters the season looking to pick up where she left off after earning Preseason All-OVC honors, averaging 11.2 points, 4.7 rebounds and 1.1 blocks per game.

Perry was named OVC Freshman of the Week three times last season while earning All-Newcomer honors.

The University of Tennessee at Martin women's basketball team will officially open the regular season with the team's home opener against former conference rival and current Southern Conference foe Samford on Tuesday, Nov. 6. Tipoff from the Kathleen and Tom Elam Center is scheduled for 5:30 p.m.

The Skyhawks enter the season looking to build upon the team's past success after notching the program's seventh postseason appearance in the past eight years while posting a 19-15 overall mark and a Postseason WNIT berth. The 2018-19 version of the Skyhawks will feature just one senior, a junior and 13 freshmen and sophomores to rank as one of the youngest teams in the nation.

Returning to key roles are Preseason All-OVC honorees Chelsey Perry and Emany Robertson. Perry burst onto the scene last season by averaging 11.2 points, 4.7 rebounds, 1.3 steals, 1.2 assists and 1.1 blocks in 26.4 minutes per game as a freshman. She was rewarded for her strong play by being named to the OVC All-Newcomer squad along with the OVC All-Tournament team while notching three OVC Freshman of the Week honors. Meanwhile, Robertson returns as a fourth year starter having played in 97 games while tallying 10.9 points, 3.5 rebounds, 3.7 assists and 1.7 steals per game. For her career she has scored 844 points while ranking sixth in program history with 356 assists.

Samford opens the season after a 2017-18 campaign which saw the Bulldogs post a 15-16 mark while going 6-8 in SoCon play. The Bulldogs return four starters from last year's squad and 12 of 13 letterwinners. In the team's lone exhibition contest, Samford beat Berry College 72-40 with Natalie Armstrong scoring a game-high 18 points while notching eight rebounds. Katie Allen (13 points) and Samantha Fitzgerald (12 points) also scored in double figures for the Bulldogs.

Tuesday's matchup marks the 16th meeting between the two programs in a series which dates back to 1997. UT Martin holds a 9-6 series advantage while possessing a 6-1 mark against Samford in the Elam Center. The two squads last met on Nov. 23, 2016 with the Bulldogs coming out victorious 69-62.

FANS PACK THE ELAM CENTER

In a study which ranked the teams in Division I women's basketball attendance, UT Martin lead all OVC programs in home attendance with 24,986 people coming through the turnstiles of the Kathleen and Tom Elam Center last season. Hosting a total of 13 home games last season, the Skyhawks averaged 1,785 people per contest, ranking as the top OVC member and well above the national average of 1,092 and well over 2x the league average of 945.

SKYHAWKS PICKED TO FINISH SECOND

In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, UT Martin has been selected to finish second in the Ohio Valley Conference as announced at the league's annual media day on Oct. 23, 2018. The Skyhawks garnered three first place votes and notched 204 overall points while the preseason favorite Belmont earned 240 points and 20 first palace votes.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

The Skyhawks boast one of the youngest teams in the country in terms of Division I playing experience. As a whole, UT Martin has just eight years of playing experience spread over 15 eligible players on the 2018-19 roster with 10 players set to make their Division I debut this season.

POSTSEASON PLAY

UT Martin is coming off a season in which the squad earned its seventh postseason berth in the past eight years with an automatic bid into the Postseason Women's NIT, joining four consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances from 2011-14 and a pair of WNIT berths in 2015 and 2016. The Skyhawks recent success has been unprecedented after notching just one previous postseason berth in the program's Division I history coming in 1999.

SKYHAWKS GARNER ESPN SPOTLIGHT

Beginning this year, ESPN+ became the exclusive home for live web streamed athletic contests involving OVC schools. ESPN+ is a multi-sport, direct-to-consumer subscription streaming service from The Walt Disney Company Direct-to-Consumer & International segment and ESPN. SKYHAWKS THRIVE IN OVC PLAY

Since head coach Kevin McMillan took over prior to the 2009-2010 season, the Skyhawks have posted a 114-36 overall record in OVC play, good for a winning percentage of .760. The Skyhawks have won four conference championships in the past six seasons, posting 15-1 records in both 2012 and 2014 while going 16-0 in 2015 and 14-2 in 2016.

THATS 70S SHOW

70 appears to be the magic number for UT Martin in recent history. Under the direction of head coach Kevin McMillan, the Skyhawks are 140-27. When the Skyhawks have scored 80 points or more, they are 90-6.

SKYHAWK RADIO NETWORK

The flagship station for Skyhawk women's basketball is Thunderbolt Broadcasting with its games broadcast on WCMT 1410 AM, 100.5 FM, 92.7 FM, 96.1 FM, 99.7 FM and 103.3 FM. Chris Brinkley begins his 18th year as coordinator of the Skyhawk Radio Network. Tom Britt enters his 38th year as play-by-play man for women's basketball broadcasts - serving as the longest tenured women's basketbal broadcaster in the country - with Brinkley serving as the color commentator. For road games, Brinkley will take over play-by-play responsibilities with Asst. Sports Information Director Alex Boggis providing color analysis.
