

newcomers to the fold. UT Martin is highlighted by the junior tandem of Chelsey Perry and Maddie Waldrop who

garnered Preseason All-OVC honors. Perry earned her second preseason honor in as many years after averaging 12.0 points and 5.5 rebounds per game last season. She tallied 19 games in double figures while ranked as one of the country's top shot blockers with 71 swats. Waldrop averaged 8.0 points and 7.3 rebounds while tallying three double-double – including a 20 point and 16 rebound performance in the regular season finale.

In the team's lone exhibition contest, UT Martin posted a 94-68 victory over Bethel. The Skyhawks scored in double figures while Perry led the team with 21 points, 11 rebounds and three blocks in just 23 minutes of action. Also scoring in double figures was the duo of Tamiah Stanford (17 points) and Brittni Moore (14 points). UT Martin would shoot 44.6 percent from the field and 50.0 percent from beyond the arc while forcing 21 turnovers.

The Skyhawks are under the direction of 11th-year head coach Kevin McMillan. Since taking over in 2009, McMillan has posted a career mark of 196-126 to rank third all-time amongst OVC coaches and first in program history.

Saint Louis (0-0) welcomes back six players from a squad which went 15-16 last season. Sophomores Ciaja Harbison (14.6 ppg, 4.5 apg) and Brooke Flowers (8.0 ppg, 8.5 rpg) earned Atlantic 10 Conference preseason accolades after strong breakout campaigns. The Billikens are coached by Lisa Stone who is in her eighth season at Saint Louis where she has posted a 122-

Wednesday's matchup marks the 11th meeting between the two programs in a series which dates back to 1993. UT Martin holds a 7-3 advantage in the series and has won the last three meetings despite not facing each other since 2012.



#### SKYHAWKS MATCHED UP AGAINST THE BEST

As the Skyhawks head into the season, the schedule is as daunting as ever. According to the Preseason Coaches Poll, the Skyhawks will play No. 8 Mississippi State, No. 9 Louisville, No. 22 Arkansas and No. 23 Gonzaga in non-conference play.

#### SKYHAWKS PICKED TO FINISH SECOND

In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, UT Martin has been selected to finish second in the Ohio Valley Conference as announced at the league's annual media day on Oct. 22, 2019. The Skyhawks garnered nine first place votes and notched 227 overall points while the preseason favorite Belmont earned 234 points and 14 first palace votes.

#### HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

UT Martin has tallied 245 home victories since 1995, making the friendly confines of the Elam Center a daunting place for visiting teams. During McMillan's tenure the Skyhawks have posted a 102-24 record at home since taking over as head coach, posting an .809 winning percentage. The Skyhawks have also posted a 73-11 home record against OVC foes during the same span. The Skyhawks were especially successful at home during the 2018-19 season as the squad recorded the most wins at the Elam Center is school history by going 14-1.

#### PERRY AND WALDROP NAMED ALL-OVC

The UT Martin women's basketball junior duo of Chelsey Perry and Maddie Waldrop were recognized at Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Media Day as Preseason All-OVC honorees.

Perry is a two-time Preseason All-OVC honoree after averaging 12.0 points and 5.5 rebounds per game last season. Perry scored in double figures in 19 contests while tallying four games with at least 20 points. She scored a season-high 28 points against Tennessee Tech while ranking 24th nationally with 71 blocks and 30th with 2.22 blocks per game.

Waldrop took the next step in her progression in 2018-19, averaging 8.0 points and 7.3 rebounds per game en route to being named a Preseason All-OVC honoree. Waldrop scored in double figures 10 times while recording three double-doubles. She also ranked sixth in the OVC in defensive rebounds (4.8), ninth in total rebounds (7.3) and 10th in offensive rebounds (2.5).
