#31 • KYANNAH GRANT

Junior guard Kyannah Grant was named to the Holiday Hoops Classic All-Tournament Team after scoring 14 points and dishing out five assists against Bowling Green. She made 6-of-7 field goal attempts while connecting on her lone three-point attempt.

Grant is averaging 6.5 points, 3.6 rebounds and 2.6 assists in 35.9 minutes per game this season.

- The University of Tennessee at Martin women's basketball team opens its 30th season of competition in the Ohio Valley Conference with a road matchup at Austin Peay on Thursday, Dec. 30. Tipoff from the Dunn Center is scheduled for 5 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN+.
- The Skyhawks (3-8, 0-0 OVC) enter OVC play looking to defend back-to-back regular season championships after a tough non-conference slate. During UT Martin's two-year championship run the program posted a 33-4 record in league play – including a 15-3 mark on the road.
- UT Martin is hoping to lean upon the team's previous success in league play to snap its current six-game losing streak since Thanksgiving. The Skyhawks dropped their most recent outing prior to Christmas at the South Point Holiday Hoops Classic in Las Vegas to Bowling Green by a score of 67-52. After struggling early in the contest, the Skyhawks posted their highest scoring second half of the season while Paige Pipkin (15 points, five steals) and Kyannah Grant (14 points, five assists) led the team offensively.
- Thursday's matchup features two coaches on the opposite end of the spectrum in terms of head coaching experience. UT Martin is led by four-time OVC Coach of the Year Kevin McMillan who is in his 13th season as the league's longest tenured coach and third winningest coach in conference history with a 243-150 record – including a 160-45 mark in OVC play. Meanwhile for Austin Peay, Brittany Young is in her first season leading the Gobs.
- Austin Peay (7-3, 0-0 OVC) enters its final season of OVC play looking to build upon its recent success with a four-game winning streak in the wings. During that four-game stretch the Gobs have not trailed their opponent while posting an average margin of victory of 22.2 points. The Gobs rely heavily on the shoulders of OVC transfers Yamia Johnson (Jacksonville State) and Karle Pace (Eastern Illinois) to lead the way. Johnson has won a pair of OVC Player of the Week honors and is averaging 16.4 points and 6.0 rebounds per game while Pace isn't far behind in the scoring column with 14.4 points and 2.9 assists per game.
- This marks the 94th meeting between the two programs in a series which dates back to 1970 with UT Martin holding a narrow 47-46 series advantage. The Skyhawks have won seven straight games against the Gobs – including three consecutive single-digit victories in the Dunn Center.

GRANT NAMED TO HOLIDAY

HOOPS CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

• The Skyhawk guard Kyannah Grant was named to the Holiday Hoops Classic All-Tournament Team after tallying 14 points and five assists in the team's lone game of the tournament against Bowling Green in Las Vegas.

INJURIES TAKE THEIR TOLL

• UT Martin has seen the injury bug wreck havoc on the team's fortunes early in the season. To date, the Skyhawks have had a projected starter out of every game while several players have missed multiple contests. Between the mixture of Ella Thompson (9), Seygan Robins (6), Holly Forbes (2) and Paige Pipkin (1) alone, the Skyhawks have missed 18 starts in 11 games.

PIPKIN FINDS HER GROOVE

• Skyhawk junior guard Paige Pipkin has proven to be the team's most dependable offensive contributor this season. Through the non-conference slate she averaged 12.3 points per game with six double-figure performances - including a season-high 20 points against No. 24 Virginia Tech in the San Juan Shootout.

DEFENSE IS KEY

• The Skyhawks have been impressive on the defensive end this season. UT Martin has held four opponents below 50 points on the year while limiting all but three of 11 opponents to fewer than 60 points. The Skyhawks currently rank first in the OVC in scoring defense, allowing an average of 54.0 points per game.

LOOKING FORWARD TO THE NEW YEAR

• No team in the country is looking more forward to the calendar flipping over to the new year more than UT Martin. The Skyhawks hit a rough patch in the month of December by going 0-4 in the month. Historically the Skyhawks have done well once the new year hits posting a 171-54 record under the direction of head coach Kevin McMillan since 2010. Over the past 13 seasons UT Martin is 73-26 in January, 74-14 in February and 24-14 in March.

SKYHAWKS MATCH UP AGAINST THE BEST

• UT Martin has never shyed away from playing some of the best teams in the country under head coach Kevin McMillan. Since taking over in 2009-10, McMillan and the Skyhawks have played 26 nationally ranked opponents. This season the Skyhawks are primed to matchup against two teams currently in the top-25 in No. 6 Louisville and No. 24 Virginia Tech.

• Additionally, Skyhawks will face seven teams which earned postseason berths last season including Belmont, Louisville, N.C. A&T and Virginia Tech which played in the NCAA Tournament while Bowling Green, Illinois State and Saint Louis appeared in the WNIT.

UT MARTIN FROM DEEP

• UT Martin has one of the longest streaks in the nation with a made three-pointer heading into the 2021-22 season. The Skyhawks have made a three-pointer in 404 consecutive games, a streak which dates back to Feb. 3, 2009 against Austin Peay and ranks eighth nationally.

SUCCESS IN PRESEASON WNIT

• This season marked the second time that UT Martin has participated in the WNIT Preseason Classic while combining to go 4-2 in the two appearances. The Skyhawks last participated in the event in 2013 with the team going 2-1, picking up wins over Georgia State (84-80) and Quinnipiac (102-97, OT) while dropping a road matchup at No. 25 Gonzaga (L, 91-54). In the three games to open the season, the Skyhawks dropped the opener to Kansas State (44-30) before picking up wins over North Carolina A&T (58-40) and Western Kentucky (63-47).

FORBES AND PIPKIN NAMED TO PRESEASON WNIT ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

• The Skyhawk pair of forward Holly Forbes and guard Paige Pipkin garnered WNIT Preseason Classic All-Tournament honors from the Kansas City Pod after impressive showings, leading the team to a 2-1 record. Forbes led the team by averaging 14.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game while Pipkin chipped in 9.7 points, 4.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists.

FORBES NAMED OVC NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

• Graduate transfer Holly Forbes picked OVC Newcomer of the Week honors in back-to-back weeks to start the season with the team's swing through the WNIT Preseason Classic along with matchups against Louisville and Illinois State. Her second honor came after averaging 11.0 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.3 steals and 1.6 assists per game against WKU, Louisville and Illinois State. She scored in double figures in two of three contests, beginning with 16 points and nine rebounds in the win over Western Kentucky in the final game of the WNIT Preseason Classic to claim all-tournament honors. Then against No. 10 Louisville she posted six points, nine rebounds, four steals and two assists. Finally, in the team's home-opener against Illinois State she tossed in 11 points and seven rebounds in the win.

BACK-TO-BACK CHAMPIONS

• UT Martin posted its third back-to-back OVC regular season championship in 2020-21. The Skyhawks went back-to-back-to-back in 2014, 2015 and 2016 while also winning back-to-back titles in 2020 and 2021. Overall, the Skyhawks are the 22nd OVC program to win back-to-back titles in league history.

POSTSEASON WINS FOR HISTORY BOOKS

• With a pair of postseason wins in the WNIT last season against Louisiana (58-48) and Illinois State (64-59), the Skyhawks posted the program's third and fourth postseason wins in the team's Division I history. The two victories also marked the first time that an Ohio Valley Conference program has won multiple postseason contests in a single season. UT Martin has also picked up victories in the 1999 WNIT against Ole Miss (77-66) and 2016 against Memphis (79-73).

UT MARTIN IN THE POSTSEASON

• UT Martin earned its ninth postseason berth in the past 10 years with an automatic bid into the Postseason Women's NIT, joining four consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances from 2011-14 and four of WNIT qualifications in 2015, 2016, 2018 and 2020 (canceled). The Skyhawks recent success has been unprecedented after notching just one previous postseason berth in the program's Division I history coming in 1999.

HANG ANOTHER BANNER

• With a 17-2 campaign, the Skyhawks notched their seventh OVC regular season championship in program history and back-to-back league title. Overall, UT Martin has won league championships in 1998-99, 2011-12, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2019-20 and 2020-21.

THAT 70's SHOW

• 70 has proven to be the magic number for the Skyhawks in recent history. Under the direction of head coach Kevin McMillan, UT Martin is 182-35 when eclipsing the 70-point plateau. When the Skyhawks have scored 80 points or more, they are 115-7 during the same span.

- Former UT Martin women's basketball star Chelsey Perry made both program and Ohio Valley Conference history by being selected 26th overall by the Indiana Fever in the third round of the 2021 WNBA Draft. Perry is the first player in UT Martin history to be taken in the WNBA Draft while ranking as the highest selection in OVC history.
- The 6-2 forward wrapped up her Skyhawk career with several individual and team accomplishments including being named a two-time OVC Player of the Year and 13-time OVC Player of the Week while also leading the program to back-to-back league championships and becoming the first OVC team to wins multiple postseason contests with two victories in the 2021 WNIT. The eighth head coach in UT Martin women's basketball history, Kevin McMillan is in his 13th year at the helm of the Skyhawk program as the school's all-time wins leader with 240 career victories.

Overall, the Skyhawks have won 10 Ohio Valley Conference titles during his 12 seasons at UT Martin - including six regular season titles and four tournament crowns. The Skyhawks reached the postseason in six consecutive seasons and nine seasons overall while reaching the NCAA Tournament in 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 while earning a bid to the Women's NIT in 2015, 2016, 2018, 2020 (canceled) and 2021. Additionally, the program has recorded eight 20-win seasons in the past 10 years with the Skyhawks posting a 240-142 record under McMillan, including a 160-45 mark in conference play. His 240 victories rank as the third-highest win total in OVC history, as he accounts for four OVC Coach of the Year awards.

Off the court, McMillan's teams have exceeded the average NCAA Academic Progress Rate in each of his 12 seasons. He has produced two OVC Scholar-Athletes (the highest individual honor in the league) and has graduated 100 percent of his student-athletes who have completed their eligibility in his Skyhawk tenure.

Despite the 2020-21 season facing numerous challenges related to COVID-19 the Skyhawks posted yet another banner year. UT Martin notched its 11th 20-win season in program history after going 22-6 overall while posting a 17-2 mark in league play for the team's seventh regular season championship. In addition to the team's championship run, the squad earned a berth to the WNIT where they posted a pair of wins over Louisiana and Illinois State to become the first team in OVC history to record multiple victories in the same postseason.

Highlighting the season individually was the play of All-OVC forwards Chelsey Perry and Dasia Young who both earned first team honors. Perry was named the OVC Player of the Year for the second straight season after leading the league in multiple statistical categories including scoring (22.9 ppg), field goal percentage (50.2 percent) and field goals made (164). Following the season, Perry made waves by becoming the highest selection in OVC history by being selected 26th overall in the WNBA Draft by the Indiana Fever.

The Skyhawks posted their sixth league title in program history in 2019-20 after posting a 22-10 overall record while going 16-2 in league action. UT Martin would receive a berth into the Women's NIT after falling in the OVC Basketball Championship finals but the postseason event would be canceled because of COVID-19. In a season in which injuries plagued the roster, the Skyhawks continually rose to the occasions with its 10th 20-win season in program history while featuring a pair of All-OVC first-team performers in Perry and Maddie Waldrop.

Perry dominated postseason honors by being named WBCA Coaches' All-American honorable mention, a finalist for the Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year and OVC Player of the Year selection after ranking first nationally in field goal made (286), second in total points (740) and third in both points per game (23.1) and field goal attempts (386). Meanwhile, Waldrop earned her first All-OVC honor after ranking amongst OVC leaders in defensive rebounds (5.9, fourth), field goal percentage (48.6, fifth), rebounding (7.8 rpg, seventh) and scoring (12.7 ppg, eighth).

Despite having one of the youngest teams in the country on a program which featured just one senior on the roster, the Skyhawks still managed to meet program expectations throughout the 2018-19 season. The Skyhawks would post a 23-9 overall mark while finishing tied for second in the league standings with a record of 13-5. The team's 23 wins tied for the most wins in program history while appearing in the OVC Basketball Championship title contest for the seventh time in the last nine seasons. Highlighting the season was the emergence of senior Emanye Robertson who put the finishing touches on her career with an All-OVC first team and OVC Defense Player of the Year selection. Meanwhile, sophomore Chelsey Perry earned All-OVC second team honors while freshman Brittini Moore was selected to the OVC All-Newcomer squad.

McMillan saw the Skyhawks return to the postseason for the seventh time in his tenure in 2017-18 with another appearance in the Women's NIT. The Skyhawks would ultimately post a 19-15 overall mark while notching a 13-5 mark in league play to earn the No. 2 seed in the OVC Basketball Championship – where the squad advanced to the tournament finals before falling to No. 22 ranked Belmont in overtime. With the league's automatic bid to the Women's NIT, the Skyhawks would travel to Indiana where they fell to the eventual tournament champions.

Faced with one of the youngest rosters in the nation – boasting just four returners and an abundance of key injuries – the Skyhawks' 2016-17 campaign was a year of highs and lows. UT Martin would post a 12-19 overall record while finishing 8-8 in league play – earning the No. 4 seed in the OVC Basketball Championship before ultimately falling in the tournament semifinals. While the season failed to meet expectations, the squad found growth as three Skyhawks earned All-OVC honors. Spray highlighted the season by becoming just the program's third OVC Freshman of the Year while joining Feldhaus and Mason on the All-OVC second team.

The Skyhawks found success once again during the 2015-16 season, notching the program's eighth 20-win season after finishing with a 22-10 overall record and a 14-2 league mark despite playing with just seven healthy scholarship players for much of the year. The Skyhawks notched their third consecutive regular season title, ranking as the third program in conference history and first since 1993. After winning the season championship, the Skyhawks clinched their sixth straight postseason berth, earning a berth in the Women's NIT where they advanced to the second round before falling to Western Kentucky after defeating Memphis – notching the program's first postseason victory since 1999. With the squad's success, McMillan notched his second straight OVC Coach of the Year award – marking just the second time in league history that a coach has won the award in back-to-back seasons.

The 2014-15 season kept with the theme of several program firsts within McMillan's tenure while the squad's 22-11 overall record marked the program's seventh 20-win season. UT Martin notched yet another piece of OVC history after becoming just the sixth team in league history to finish the conference season with an unblemished record and just the second to finish 16-0. With the perfect conference record, the Skyhawks clinched their third OVC season title in the last four years while posting a league record of 46-2 during the stretch. The season also served as the fifth consecutive postseason appearance for the Skyhawks after earning an invitation to the Women's National Invitational Tournament against Ole Miss.

McMillan's 2013-14 squad recorded its sixth OVC championship during a four-year period with both a regular season and tournament championship. The McMillan led Skyhawks set new program records in victories with 24, while setting a new single season scoring record with 2,681 points en route to receiving the program's first votes in the USA TODAY Sports Top 25 Coaches' Poll and a near upset in the NCAA Tournament against No. 7 North Carolina.

The Skyhawks were led by the play of two premier senior guards in Heather Butler and Jasmine Newsome. Butler finished her career as UT Martin and the OVC's all-time leading scorer with 2,865 career points after being named the league's Player of the Year. Butler finished tied for 16th on the NCAA's all-time scoring list while scoring in double figures every game of her career, spanning 129 games and ranking fifth all-time. She also left the Skyhawks as the best three-point shooter in NCAA history after tying the career three-pointers record with 392.

Joining Butler with postseason accolades was the highly decorated Newsome. Newsome notched her third OVC Defensive Player of the Year honor while finishing her Skyhawk career as the school and league's second all-time leading scorer – second to Butler – with 2,566 career points. The two-time OVC Player of the Year was also named All-Mid Major Player of the Year and Mid Major All-American by College Sports Madness.

In his fourth year, the Skyhawks notched their third consecutive OVC Tournament championship during the 2012-13 season, downing No. 2 seed Tennessee Tech 87-80 in overtime on March 9, 2013. With the victory, UT Martin would advance to their third straight trip to the NCAA Tournament, to take on the Notre Dame Fighting Irish. The Skyhawks suffered a 97-64 setback to the eventual National Championship runner-up despite Butler scoring a tournament-best 37 points in the contest.

In 2011-12, McMillan's Skyhawks captured their second OVC Tournament championship in program history, downing No. 3 seed Tennessee Tech 82-65 on March 5. With the victory, UT Martin advanced to make its second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, traveling to the Horizon Center in Rosemont, Ill., to take on the Tennessee Lady Vols. The Skyhawks suffered a 72-49 setback to the hands of alumnus Pat Head Summitt.

Consisting of a roster of mostly West Tennessee players, the Skyhawks went 23-9 with a 15-1 OVC mark despite having a relatively young roster which featured just one senior. The 23-win season was the second consecutive 20-win slate for the Skyhawks while also leading the nation in scoring with 80.1 points per game. The Skyhawks were also the nation's top team in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.43) and sixth in assists (17.7 apg).

The 2010-11 season laid the foundation for the future, as three different Skyhawks combined to win an OVC Record 13 Freshmen of the Week honors along with the OVC Team Sportsmanship Award. McMillan's guided the team to a second place finish during the regular season before winning the program's first OVC Tournament title. With the title, the Skyhawks earned its first berth in the NCAA Tournament and played at Cameron Indoor Arena against the Duke Blue Devils.

The Skyhawks went 21-11 with a 14-4 OVC mark in 2010-11 despite having a roster that was the youngest team in America (only two years of Division-I experience heading into the season). The 20-win season was the first since 1998-99 and fourth 20-win campaign in program history.

McMillan's first season at UT Martin was a transformation in every sense of the work as he took over a program that had just finished 2-27 and went winless in conference play. Under his direction the Skyhawks finished the 2010-11 season with an overall record 11-19 while making the program's first OVC Tournament appearance since 2006-07. McMillan took his team all the way to the semifinals of the tournament along with being named OVC Coach of the Year and TSWA Women's Co-Head Coach of the Year.

Prior to being named head coach of the Skyhawks on June 15, 2009, McMillan posted a decorated career as a high school coach within the state of Tennessee. Through his 17 years in the prep ranks, the accumulated a record of 435-126 while winning one state championships and sporting six state tournament appearances. He has had coaching stints at Gibson County High School in Dyer (2007-09), Westview High School in Martin (1997-2005) and Millington High School in Millington (1990-97). McMillan was twice named the Jackson Sun's West Tennessee Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2009, while being tabbed district Coach of the Year 10 times. He also spent two season as an assistant coach at Middle Tennessee State.

McMillan played basketball at Wake Forest for one season (1985) before transferring to Rhodes College to finish out his career from 1986-89. At Rhodes, he was a three-time all-conference selection and in 1988 was named the Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference Player of the Year. In only three seasons, he scored 1,372 career points and still ranks ninth all-time at Rhodes for career points scored.

McMillan received his bachelor's degree in math and business in 1989 from Rhodes, then completed his master's in health and human performance at Middle Tennessee in 2007. He has two sons, Matt and Ben, along with one daughter, Alli.
