FULL COURT PRESS



 For the 12th time in program history, the University of Tennessee at Martin women's basketball team will compete for the Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Championship crown when going head-to-head against top seeded Southern Indiana.

- The Skyhawks (16-15) knocked off the No. 2 seed Little Rock in the OVC Basketball Championship semifinals on Friday afternoon in a contest which features nine lead changes

 including six in the fourth quarter. UT Martin led by as much as seven in the third quarter before hanging tough late in the game to pull out a 54-48 victory.
- UT Martin will be making its 12th championship game appearance while winning four
 consecutive tournament crowns from 2010-14. The Skyhawks posted another impressive
 stint with championship game appearances in four straight tournaments from 2018-21 but
 could not get over the final hump to cut down the nets. Overall, the Skyhawks are 4-8 in
 title game matchups.
- Since head coach Kevin McMillan took over the reigns prior to the 2009-10 season, the Skyhawks have won 10 OVC championships – including six regular season crowns and four tournament titles. McMillan's 10 league championships lead all active OVC coaches – men or women – while sitting seven above Morehead State men's basketball coach Preston Spradlin.
- While Saturday's contest will determine the 2024 OVC Basketball Championship winner,
 UT Martin has already claimed the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. With
 No. 1 seed Southern Indiana currently in its four-year reclassification process to Division I,
 the Screaming Eagles are ineligible for NCAA operated events. Due to conference policy,
 the Skyhawks will receive the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament field with
 its semifinal victory.
- Southern Indiana (23-6) earned the No. 1 seed in the tournament field after going 17-1
 in league action to claim its first regular season title since joining the OVC. The Screaming
 Eagles have won nine straight games heading into Saturday's contest, including a 69-54
 semifinal victory over Eastern Illinois on Friday afternoon.
- Saturday's game marks the fourth meeting between the two programs with UT Martin holding a 2-1 advantage in the all-time series. After sweeping the season series in 2022-23, UT Martin dropped its lone matchup against Southern Indiana back on Feb. 15 by a narrow 73-67 margin.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

• Sophomore forward **Anaya Brown** cleaned up the boards in a big way against Southeast Missouri by tallying a careerligh 20 rebounds in the home victory. Brown secured nine offensive rebounds and 11 defensive boards to become just the third player in program history - joining Mary Kate Long (27) and Phyllisha Mitchell (21 and 20) - to eclipse 20 rebounds in a game.

FAST START FOR McCARN

• Skyhawk guard **Kenley McCarn** has started her career on the right foot by scoring in double figures in 28 of her 31 career games. While she opened her collegiate career with 31 points against Troy last season and added another 31-point appearance against South Dakota, she is averaging 16.7 points during her Skyhawk career.

BROWN AND RUBEL SNAG DOUBLE-DOUBLES

• The sophomore tandem of **Anaya Brown** (14 points, 20 rebounds) and **Lexi Rubel** (11 points and 10 rebounds) combined for 30 of the team's 49 rebounds against Southeast Missouri while both recording double-doubles. The game marked the first time that the Skyhawks had a pair of double-double performances in the same game since all-conference forwards Chelsey Perry and Maddie Waldrop accomplished the feat back on Jan. 4, 2020 against Austin Peay.

FIVE SKYHAWKS IN DOUBLE FIGURES

• UT Martin placed five players in double figures for the first time this season in a win over Evansville. Kenley McCarn scored a game-high 23 points while Anaya Brown (18), Love Mays (17), Morgan Borgstadt (15) and Lexi Rubel (13) also reached double figures in the victory.

The eighth head coach in UT Martin women's basketball history, Kevin McMillan is in his 15th year at the helm of the Skyhawk program as the school's all-time wins leader with 265 career victories.

Overall, the Skyhawks have won 10 Ohio Valley Conference titles during his 14 seasons at UT Martin – including six regular season titles and four tournament crowns. The Skyhawks reached the postseason in six consecutive seasons and nine seasons overall while reaching the NCAA Tournament in 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 along with earning a bid to the Women's NIT in 2015, 2016, 2018, 2020 (canceled) and 2021. Additionally, the program has recorded eight 20-win seasons in the past 12 years with the Skyhawks posting a 265-177 record under McMillan, including a 178-63 mark in conference play. His 265 victories rank as the third-highest win total in OVC history, as he accounts for four OVC Coach of the Year awards.

During his tenure, the Skyhawks have garnered 39 All-OVC selections, including 17 first team honorees, nine second team selections and 13 All-Newcomer picks. Those selections also include six OVC Player of the Year awards by the group of Heather Butler (2014), Ashia Jones (2015), Jasmine Newsome (2012 and 2013) and Chelsey Perry (2020 and 2021). Additionally, the Skyhawks have claimed four OVC Defensive Player of the Year honors from Jasmine Newsome (2011, 2012 and 2013) and Emanye Roberts (2019) while the quartet of Butler (2011), Sharneece Currie-Jelks (2023), Jones (2014) and Kendall Spray (2017) earned OVC Freshman of the Week awards.

Off the court, McMillan's teams have exceeded the average NCAA Academic Progress Rate in each of his 14 seasons. He has produced two OVC Scholar-Athletes (the highest individual honor in the league) and has graduated 100 percent of his student-athletes who have completed their eligibility in his Skyhawk tenure.
